

CLASS ATTIRE



Our dancers are expected to dress properly for class each week. This plays a large role in the professionalism of our studio and tremendously helps our students to take dance seriously. As instructors, we do enforce our dress code and appreciate your help with this. Below you will find all you need to know! :)

● DRESS CODE FOR ALL CLASSES

Clothing- Tights and leotard; any color and any style.

Shoes- Ballet- pink ballet shoes

Tap- black tap shoes

Jazz- tan slip on jazz shoes

Musical Theatre- tan slip on jazz shoes

Pom- tan slip on jazz shoes

Lyrical- tan or pink half-ballet shoes

Hip Hop- silver sequin Balera high top sneakers

Optional- Spandex shorts, leggings, tutu or skirt over leotard and tights.
No other clothing is allowed.

● WHERE TO SHOP

We carry A F F O R D A B L E ballet, tap and jazz shoes at our Brookings studio along with tights, leotards and tutus. The shoes we carry in stock are high quality, professional dance shoes, ranging in price from \$20 - \$35. We also recommend Target or Dancewear Solutions.

The only items we do not carry in stock are hip hop sneakers, half-ballet shoes and pointe shoes.

● SPRING RECITAL ATTIRE

We order costumes for each dancer to wear in our Spring Recital. We measure each dancer in November and then order the costumes. These costumes are professionally 'made-to-order', but not 'custom-made'; your costume may require slight alterations to achieve the perfect fit. Costumes are passed out in class in February or March. You will need to provide your own tights and shoes for the recital. Costumes range from \$65-75 per dancer, per class. ● CHRISTMAS SHOWCASE ATTIRE

To keep costs to a minimum we do not order costumes for our Christmas Showcase. Instead, we order a tanktop for each dancer to wear in our Showcase. These are passed out in class in December. Basically, we wear the matching tank tops over our regular dance attire for the Showcase- our best effort to create a unified 'look' without costumes. Tanks are \$12 per dancer.
