WELCOME TO OUR REGULAR SEASON PROGRAM

Our 'regular season' dance program is a continuous nine month program that runs weekly from September thru May. Our season is based on 34 weeks of scheduled classes plus 2 performances (one in December and one in May).

MONTHLY TUITION PAYMENTS

Tuition is charged on a monthly basis, on the 2nd of each month from September 2 thru May 2 (nine payments). Tuition remains the same each month regardless if the month has 3, 4, or 5 weeks of class. At the end of the season, all dancers will have completed 34 weeks of scheduled classes plus 2 performances. Your monthly payment is based on the total class time per week, per dancer.

Example: Junior Hip Hop 45 Minute Class + Junior Pom 45 Minute Class = 90 minutes per week = \$80 per month (NOT \$96).

PAYMENT POLICY: We process monthly tuition payments by automatic withdrawal via credit or debit card. Cash/Check is not accepted for tuition payments unless you are paying for the entire nine months in full (contact Brooke for information on yearly payments, we do offer a 5% discount if received by July 1). Sales Tax (6.5%) is added to all payments.

CANCELLATION POLICY: To receive the best experience possible, we encourage all dancers to join us for the nine month season. To cancel or change your class registration and stop monthly auto-pay, you must fill out our Class Change/Cancellation Form by the 15th of the month. If you are dropping class after November 15, you will be charged a \$50 'Early Cancellation Fee' (many of our classes fill to capacity and we want to make sure they're filled with dancers intending to join us for the entire season).

FAMILY DISCOUNT: 10% discount on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th dancer in your family.

COSTUMES FOR PERFORMANCES

For our Christmas Showcase, we order matching shirts for dancers to wear. This is a way for us to look like a cohesive group without going to the expense of ordering costumes. Shirts are \$25 each plus tax. This fee is added to your November tuition payment.

For our Spring Recital, we order professional costumes. Costumes are \$65 each (Petite/Beginner classes), \$75 each (Junior classes) and \$85 each (Intermediate and Advanced classes). This fee is per dancer, per class, plus tax. If you are in more than one class, you will have more than one costume. A 50% costume deposit is due with November tuition and the 50% balance is due with December tuition, charged via auto-pay. Once paid, all costume fees are non-refundable, regardless if your child drops class prior to the recital.

PAYMENT INFO

For your convenience and our transparency, an outline of the seasonal payment schedule is provided below. These payments will be automatically charged to your card on file on the dates listed.

If your automatic payment is declined, you will receive an email with information on how to proceed to take care of your outstanding balance. If no action is taken, a \$10 late fee is applied to your account after the 10th of each month. Dancers with outstanding balances 30 days past due are dropped from class and can reenroll once a full payment has been made.

CHRISTMAS SHOWCASE: Saturday December 16, 2023 @ 5pm

SPRING RECITAL: Saturday May 18, 2024 @ 5pm

All dancers perform in both our Christmas Showcase and Spring Recital. These performances are held at the SDSU Oscar Larson Performing Arts Center. A mandatory dress rehearsal is held during the afternoon. Tickets are \$10 general admission and \$15 reserved.

PARENT PORTAL + ABSENCE REPORTING

ATTENDANCE

You can report your child's absence in the online Parent Portal. Tuition is non-refundable for missed classes, but you are welcome to make up your time by attending a similar style and age-level class. Contact Brooke to schedule a make up lesson.

PERFORMANCE POLICY APPLICABLE TO DANCERS AGE 1ST GRADE AND UP ★

Dancers must be at class the one week prior to an upcoming performance. If you are not at class you do not perform, unless a private lesson has been scheduled; fees apply. Additionally, during November/December and April/May, dancers are allowed one absence each month in order to participate in the Christmas Showcase and Spring Recital. Any additional absences must be made up during a private lesson; fees apply. There are no exceptions to this policy regardless of the reason for your absence. We sincerely don't mean to cause inconveniences for busy families, but our staff and dancers work hard to provide quality performances, which requires dedication from each and every dancer. We appreciate your understanding!

CLASS OBSERVATION

To keep the whole class focused and to provide the best environment for both our dancers and instructors, parents/guests are not allowed in the studio during class time. Our classes are livestreamed on a TV in our lobby- parents are welcome to stay and watch class on the TV. We also offer SpotTV (an app to view class from your mobile device. \$5/month. Contact Brooke or our front desk staff to sign up.)

CLASS TIMES

Our building opens 15 minutes before class starts and closes shortly after class ends. We are only responsible for our dance students during their scheduled class time, while they are in the studio classroom. We are not responsible for dancers waiting in the lobby before or after class without a parent. If you drop your dancer off early or pick them up late, they will be unattended and unsupervised.

WINTER WEATHER CANCELLATIONS

In the case of inclement weather, classes will be cancelled at the discretion of Brooke. Parents will receive both an email and a text if classes are cancelled. Classes will be rescheduled at a later date. Please make sure your Parent Portal has accurate contact information.

SENIOR SOLOS

We offer our high school seniors the opportunity to perform a solo at the Spring Recital as a way to showcase their hard work and dedication to dance. We will contact you during the winter of your senior year to begin the process of working on your solo. Requirements for solos:

1. Must be a member of MADS during their Junior and Senior year.
2. Must be enrolled in Ballet during their Junior and Senior year.

MILESTONE AWARD

Each year at our Spring Recital, we recognize our dancers who are celebrating their 5th, 10th and 12th recital with us. Dancers receive a trophy on stage. This is a great award to work towards and a way for us to say THANK YOU for your dedication to MADS!

Jazz, Pom, Musical Theatre:	Tan Jazz Shoes
Lyrical:	Tan Half-Ballet Shoes
Hip Hop:	Beginner & Junior: 'Balera' Silver High Top Sneakers (or similar) Intermediate & Advanced: Any type of black high top sneakers
Pointe:	Pointe shoes are optional for ballet dancers 8th grade & up who have 2 years of ballet experience. Please consult with Brooke before purchasing pointe shoes
Hair:	Hair should be pulled back in a bun/pony
