

FULL SEASON INFORMATION

2026-2027

SEASON

Our 'Full Season' is a continuous nine month program that runs from late August through mid May.

PAYMENT INFO

Tuition is charged monthly starting September 2 to May 2. Tuition remains the same each month regardless if the month has 3, 4, or 5 weeks of class. All tuition payments are processed by automatic withdrawal via credit or debit card. Sales Tax (6.2%) and Credit Card Surcharge (3%) is added to all payments (debit cards are excluded from surcharge). Tuition rates for the 2026-2027 season:

CANCELLATION POLICY: To receive the best experience possible, we encourage all dancers to join us for the nine month season. To cancel or change your class registration and stop monthly auto-pay, you must fill out our Class Change/Cancellation Form by the 15th of the month. That form can be found here: <https://forms.gle/MsREskaXKcG3yyvaq8>. If you are dropping class after November 15, you will be charged a \$50 'Early Cancellation Fee' (many of our classes fill to capacity and we want to make sure they're filled with dancers intending to join us for the entire season).

DECLINED PAYMENTS: If your automatic payment is declined, you will receive a text with information on how to proceed to take care of your outstanding balance. If no payment is made by the 10th of each month, a \$10 late fee is applied. Dancers with outstanding balances 30 days past due are dropped from class and can reenroll once a full payment has been made.

FAMILY DISCOUNT: 10% tuition discount on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th dancer in your family.

PERFORMANCES

All dance classes perform twice per season. Tumble classes do not perform. Performances are held at the SDSU Oscar Larson Performing Arts Center. Dancers in our lower level classes perform at the 4pm show and dancers in our mid and upper level classes perform at the 6pm show. A mandatory dress rehearsal is held during the afternoon the day of the show. Ticket prices are tiered at \$10, \$13 or \$15 each.

CHRISTMAS SHOWCASE: Sunday December 13, 2026. Shows @ 4pm and 6pm

SPRING RECITAL: Saturday May 15, 2027. Shows @ 4pm and 6pm

COSTUMES FOR PERFORMANCES

For the Christmas Showcase, we order matching shirts for dancers to wear. This is a way for us to look like a unified group without going to the expense of ordering costumes. Shirts are \$25 each plus tax. This fee is added to your November tuition payment.

For our Spring Recital, we order professional costumes. Costumes are \$75 each (Tiny/Petite/Beginner level classes), \$85 each (Junior level classes), \$95 each (Intermediate and Advanced level classes) and \$125 (Competition Teams). This fee is per dancer, per class, plus tax.

If you are in more than one class, you will have more than one costume. A 50% costume deposit is added to your November tuition payment and the 50% costume balance is added to your December tuition payment.

Once paid, all costume fees are non-refundable, regardless if your child drops class prior to the recital.

PERFORMANCE POLICY FOR DANCERS JUNIOR I LEVEL AND UP ★

Dancers must be at class the week of our Showcase and Recital. Additionally, during November/December and April/May, dancers are allowed one absence each month. Any additional absences must be made up during a private lesson; fees apply. We sincerely don't mean to cause inconveniences for busy families, but our staff and dancers work hard to provide quality performances, which requires dedication from each and every dancer. We appreciate your understanding!

CLASS OBSERVATION

To keep the whole class focused and to provide the best environment for both our dancers and instructors, parents/guests are not allowed in the studio during class time. Our classes are livestreamed on a TV in each lobby- parents are welcome to stay and watch.

CLASS TIMES

Our building will open 15 minutes before class starts and will close shortly after class ends. Please do not leave your dancer at the studio before or after their scheduled class time. We are only responsible for our dance students during their scheduled class time, while they are in the studio classroom. We are not responsible for dancers waiting in the lobby before or after class without a parent.

CLASS LOCATIONS

Our building has two studios, A and B. Please check in your online portal to verify in which studio your class is held. You can also check with our front desk staff upon arrival.

WHAT TO BRING

Dancers are encouraged to bring a spill-proof water bottle into the studio for class. Please leave all other belongings in the cubbies.

WINTER WEATHER CANCELLATIONS

If we cancel class due to winter weather, parents will receive both an email and a text notification. Classes will be rescheduled to a later date. Please make sure your Parent Portal has accurate contact information.

SENIOR SOLOS

We offer our high school seniors the opportunity to perform a solo at the Spring Recital as a way to showcase their hard work and dedication to dance. We will contact you during the winter of your senior year to begin the process of working on your solo.

MILESTONE AWARDS

Each year at our Spring Recital, we recognize our dancers who are celebrating their 5th, 10th and 12th recital with us. Dancers receive a trophy on stage, as well as their name on our 'Wall of Fame' at the studio. This is a great award to work towards!

WHAT TO WEAR TO CLASS: ATTIRE

Required: Tights or Leggings with Leotard or Crop Top (any color, any style).
Optional: Skirts, tutus and shorts.

Hair should be pulled back in a bun or pony.

Please do not wear hoodies, crewnecks, sweatshirts, baggy tshirts, jeans, etc.

Boys: Athletic shorts or pants with tshirt.

WHAT TO WEAR TO CLASS: SHOES

Ballet: Pink ballet shoes

Tap: Black tap shoes

Jazz & Pom: Tan jazz shoes

Lyrical: Tan turners

Hip Hop and Competitive Crew Teams: White sneakers

Competitive Elite and Premier Teams: Tan turners

Pointe: Pointe shoes are optional for ballet dancers 8th grade and up who have 2 years of ballet experience.

Please consult with Brooke prior to purchasing pointe shoes.

Tumble: No shoes are required
